Mark Walbert opened the meeting by thanking everyone for coming to the first working meeting of the Council. He then introduced Jeff Hartweg and Kevin Stewart from the Burwood Group, Inc. They gave a presentation on *The World has Changed*. This presentation addressed network and computer security issues here at Illinois State University.

Jeff opened the presentation by announcing that computer viruses are up dramatically in the last 3 years. He explained how viruses, worms, etc gain access to your computer. Response time is shrinking dramatically. Intrusion detection equipment is available but very expensive. Viruses cost an estimated \$55 billion in 2003 and are expected to increase this year. The worst case computer worm could cause \$50 billion or more in direct economic damage by attaching widely used services in MS Windows. After the presentation the floor was opened for questions and comments. The group discussed parameters of authority for a budget officer in technology.

Mark thanked Jeff and Kevin (Burwood Group, Inc.) for the presentation.

Mark mentioned that, in spite of the ominous-sounding message Council members received when they were added to the listserv for the Council, the discussions therein maybe shared with others. He also noted that he has meetings scheduled with everyone to discuss formation of their constituent advisory committee.
