Purpose: To advise and provide input to ECAT (Executive Committee for Academic Technology) and the Campus Technology Support Group (CTSG) on matters relating to student technology use at Illinois State University.

Administration: The Director of Student Technology Support Services will serve as chair of the committee. Other staff members of CTSG, including the Associate Vice President for Information Technology, will serve in auxiliary roles depending on the topic.

Term: All terms will be for one (1) academic year starting with the fall semester. Committee formation will be in early September of each year. Student Technology Support Services will work with the various appointment offices in suggesting possible student members to achieve a balance of members from different classes. There is no limit on the number of terms that may be served.

Meetings: Meetings will be scheduled approximately one per month at a time agreeable to the majority of committee members.

Expectations of Committee Members:

- Participate in short- and long-term planning initiatives for STSS operations and programs.
- Provide input on key campus technology issues that directly impact students.
- Attend regular monthly meetings
- Respond to electronic solicitations for input on pressing matters
- Seek out other student's viewpoints for broader representation
- Be informed of Illinois State technology resources for further communication to the student body
