Term: All terms will be for 1 academic year starting with the fall semester. Committee formation will be in late-August/early-September of each year. Student Technology Support Services will work with the various appointment offices in suggesting possible student members to achieve a balance of members from different classes. No limit on the number of terms that may be served.

Meetings: Meetings will be scheduled approximately one per month at a time agreeable to the majority of committee members.

- Respond to electronic solicitations for input on pressing matters
- Seek out other student's viewpoints for broader representation
- Be informed of Illinois State technology resources for further communication to the student body
