Review of the October 3, 2000 meeting (Mark & Pam)

Steve Menken of TNSS

Steve reviewed definitions and gave an overview of the campus DNS and how Zones work.

TNSS would appreciate a feedback loop to be informed of potential technical issues when a new site is add to the DNS table (like streaming video which would impact bandwidth).

TNSS would also appreciate "accountability" to be worked into the procedures, so that an inventory mechanism for zone names could keep the DNS table clean/updated.

It was brought to the group's attention that all external domains must be setup through TNSS.

It was also noted by Steve that it is not a big deal administratively to have 1 server with multiple IP's vs multiple sites with a single IP. However, this would work out better administratively on their end if the procedures were in place for accountability.

Follow up discussions

Question? How would the procedures be publicized once we write them and get them approved, so that an individual would know where to find the procedures? Suggestions: Lab Managers, CISS, STSS, Residence Hall Coordinators, LAN Coordinators.

The concept of "leasing" a DNS name was brought up.

Further discussions lead us to decide that we could draft a proposal of procedures to include TNSS's accountability process, which is different than WHAT can actually be created (our committee's job to come up with these procedures on WHAT can be created).
