

Meeting minutes from **April 25, 2003**
CAMPUS WEB PLANNING & ADVISORY COMMITTEE (WebPAC)

LiveText: Sarah introduced Molly Munson from the History Department to demo LiveText, an on-line system that teacher education students are using to guide their classes and build their ePortfolios. Presently, there are about 2000 users of LiveText (of about 4700 possible students), and should be available to the rest of the teacher education students by next Fall. Cost to the student is a one-time cd purchase of \$69, which allows them access to the system for 4 years (after which they pay about \$50 per year to maintain their account accesses). Some elementary schools now are using LiveText to manage their curriculum.

A to Z Page Link Additions: Penny and Mark presented 3 requests for inclusion in the A-Z Page list, and the committee voted to include or not to include them: 1) BloomingtonNormal.com (voted down since it is a community Web site); 2) www.ilstue.du/students/gsa (voted down since it is an RSO); and 3) iilt.ilstu.edu/Pathways (voted down since it belongs in the OUTREACH listing).

Google Server: Mark suggested that there may be a need to find funding for a Google server to support the campus. He thought if money was available soon, we could actually get one on campus.

IWSS's Detection Page: Mark and Brian presented information pertaining to a new report that Arun of IWSS created which collects information about visitors visiting certain ISU Web pages. For instance, preliminary results indicate that cookies are enabled on 98% of visitors' browsers, screen width was 97% 800px, and plugin information included Flash running on 96% of the visitors' browsers. Being able to grab these types of statistics may be valuable in more than just for the main ISU home pages.

Show and Tell: Mark asked Jeff if he could set up a "show and tell" with Chris Elvin, COE, to present video/Flash Web projects. He also asked that Penny present an updated LIFT demonstration of complex tables.

LIFT: Sarah reminded the group that her department purchased a 10-pack of LIFT to get a discounted price. She stated that there are still 7 copies available from her at that price.

Painter 8: Jeff announced to the committee that Painter 8 Developer was now available.

Budget Cut Suggestions: Jeff ran a few budget-cutting ideas past the group for feedback.
